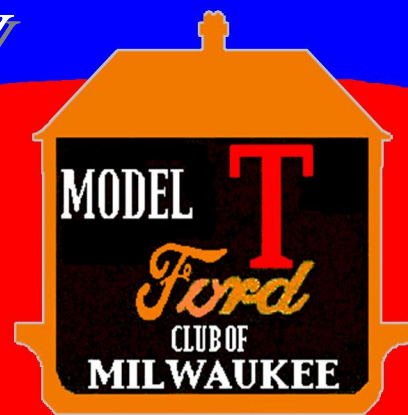

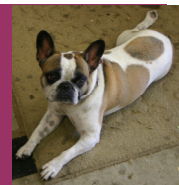
Remembering Evelyn Beaupre
