

The Night Before Christmas

There are many versions of "Twas the Night Before Christmas" written since Clement Clark Moore first penned the short story in 1823. In fact the first written of the story was called "A Visit from St. Nicholas". Here is a version that some of you may have heard on the radio, back on December 24, 1944. This is where Edgar Bergen promised Charley McCarthy a Christmas Present, if Charley would memorize and recite Moore's poem, "Twas the Night Before Christmas". The dialogue goes something like this. (**Charley**) Well... it just so happens your right this time, I do need help, you see, Bergen said that if I would recite, The Night Before Christmas, this evening, he'd give me a special Christmas present.

(**Don**) Well, that's fine. Have you memorized it? (**Charley**) Well... Part of it, that's all.
